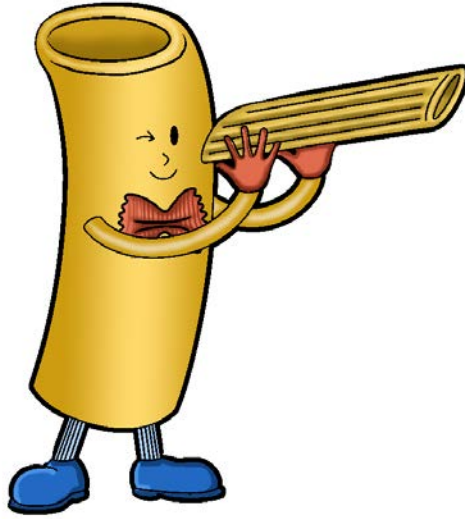

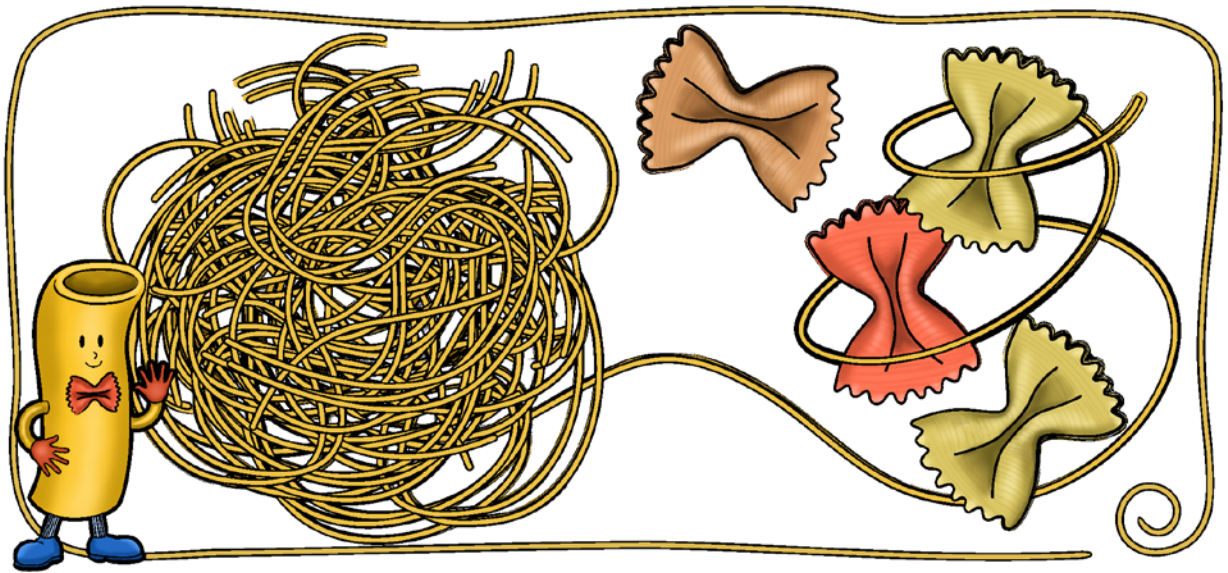

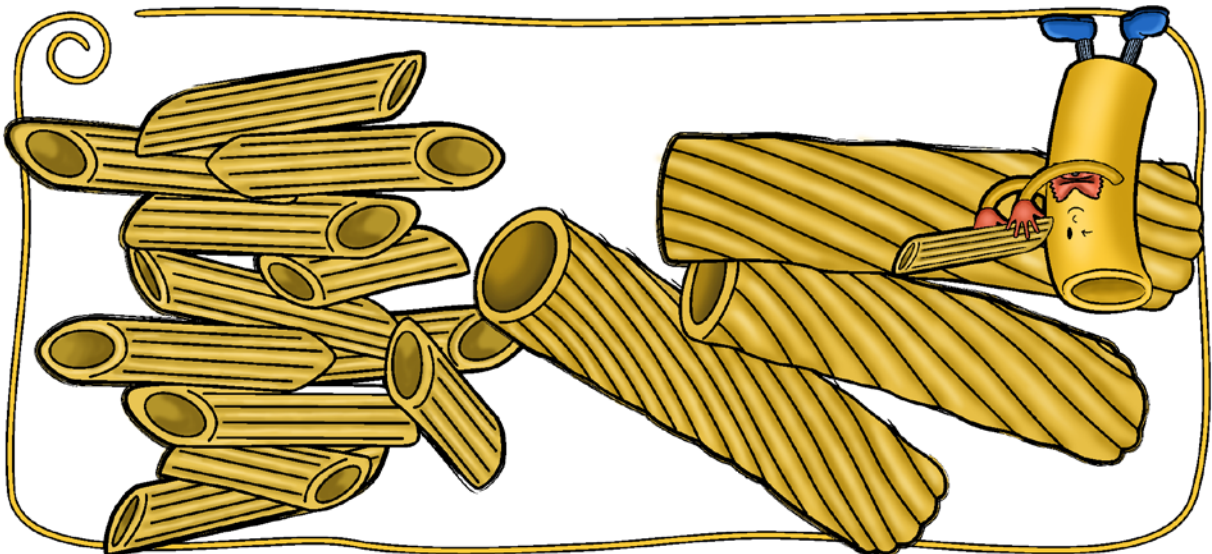
Spaghetti looks a lot like string.

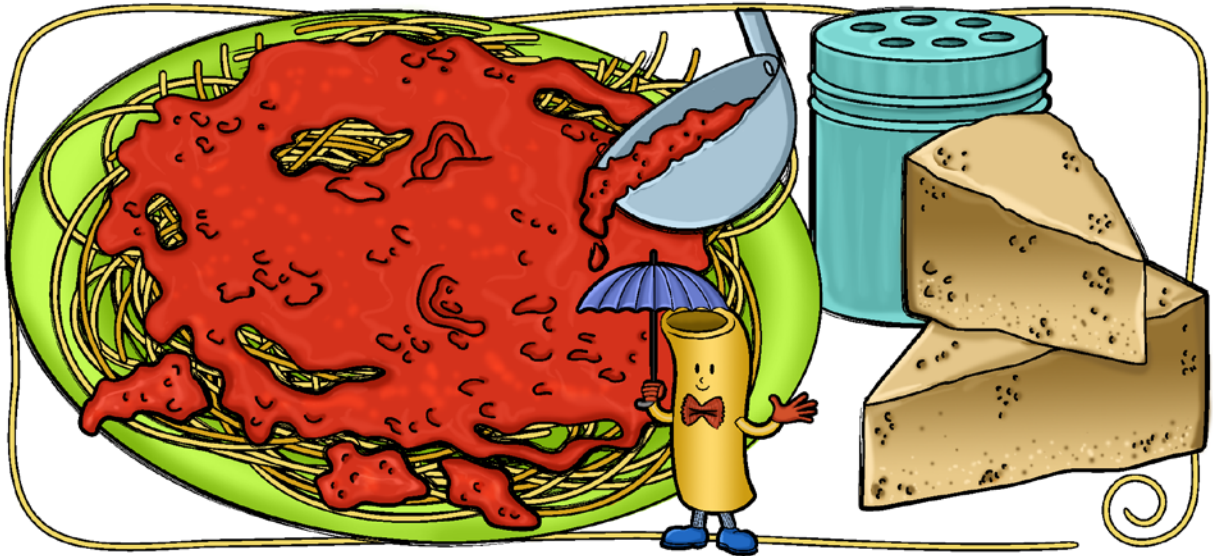

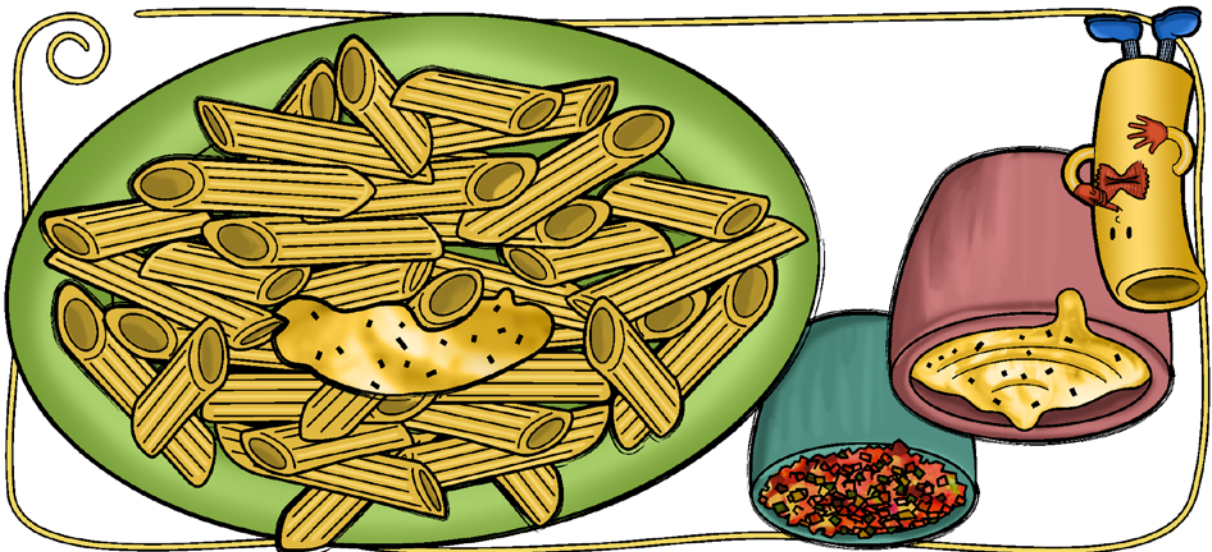
The sauce on top is often red.

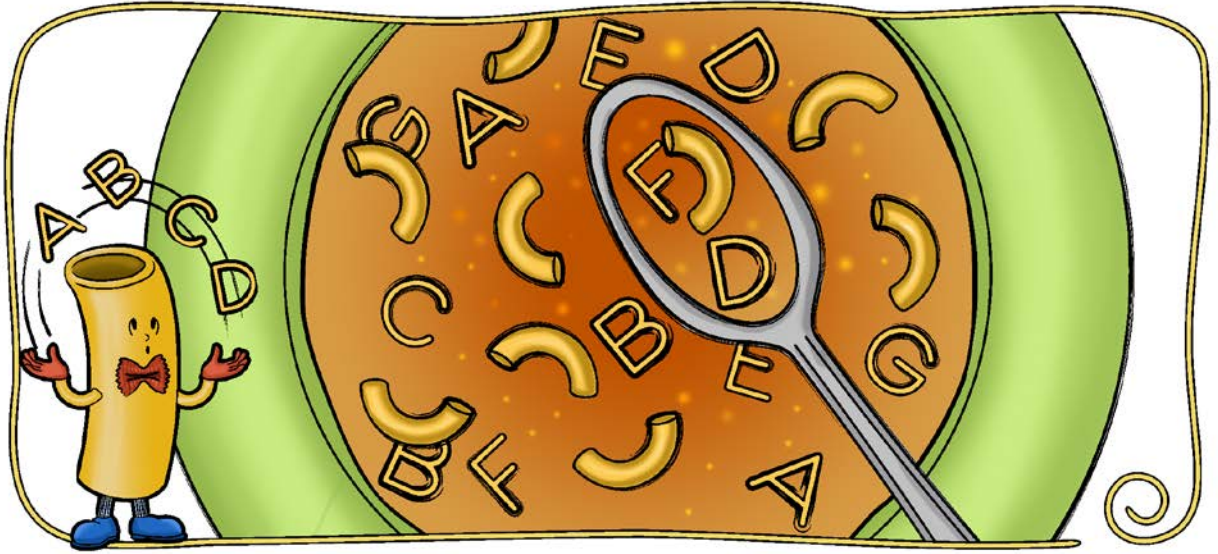
